21st Century Technology Teams

What: A summer institute for teams of educators to learn how students can use information technology to master *21st century skills*. Participants will:

- work in collaborative teams as they explore a variety of technology topics and tools
- present what they've learned to the other institute participants
- use the *Understanding by Design* process to develop standards-based projects

Each team will "earn" information technology equipment (\$900 worth per team member—e.g., a three-person team would have \$2,700 to spend). Teams will select a package of equipment that will be donated to their school district for use in their classrooms. Participants will have the opportunity use similar equipment during the week and will decide at the end of the week which items they would like to order.

Participants may attend the institute as a "conference" or a "course," in which case they would need to complete assignments and a project plan in order to earn graduate credit.

Important Note: *This institute will use a "21st century learning model." The instructors will not "stand and deliver" information—instead, teams will engage in either guided or unguided explorations of the technology tools on their own and share what they've learned with others.*

If you want someone to "just tell you all the answers," this is not the institute for you. Please come prepared to stretch at bit—to and perhaps even beyond the edge of your comfort zone! And hopefully you'll walk away with new ideas and skills for teaching in the 21st century.
